AAPG strongly recommends that you directly participate in the consultations hosted by the Alberta government;
- we thank all those who applied to be considered for a position on the ALERT's new Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC). At the time of writing, the process is not yet complete. We will provide the results by email when all decisions have been made;
- the Board offered the position of Executive Director to Victoria Chester, member of the Lethbridge Police Commission and previous AAPG Treasurer. On behalf of the Board, our new ED has been busy coordinating the planning for our 2019 conference in Medicine Hat. We look forward to seeing you there;
- alas, our Vice-Chair John Liu is no longer a member of the Calgary Police Commission and, thus, is no longer a Board member of the AAPG. As Chair, I thank John for his dedication to police governance and oversight as well as his expertise and wisdom that he generously contributed to the AAPG. We wish him well for the future;
- Nick Servos, the Chair of the Canmore Policing Committee, is our new Vice-Chair and John McDougall, of the Edmonton Police Commission, is our new Treasurer. I thank Nick and John for stepping forward and look forward to working with them both.
